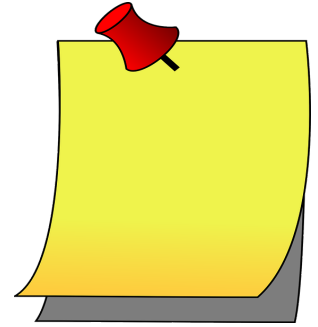


Teacher Wish List Grant 2022- 2023

Teachers spend their own money to enhance their classrooms every day.

The Teachers*Plus* Credit Union wants to support teacher members in the purchase of their 'wish list' items for the 2022- 2023 school year.



Eligible items:

- Posters, books, classroom enhancement and organization
- Items to support classroom initiatives that fit within the suggested themes
- Teacher resources (books, technology, subscriptions)
- Digital resources
- Priority will be given to items above and beyond what is typically provided by the school, Centre for Education, or NS Department of Education.

There will be 40 "Wish List" Grants awarded up to a maximum of \$300.00 per grant.

Eligibility:

- Must be currently teaching in the province of Nova Scotia.
- Preference will be given to first time applicants & Teachers*Plus* Credit Union Members
- Membership includes one of the following accounts:
 - Direct deposit
 - Mortgage
 - Loan/ Line of Credit
 - Pre-authorized payment
 - RRSP
 - Tax-free savings account
- Entrants must complete and submit the grant application form by:

Friday, December 30th, 2022.

- If you are awarded one of the grants, proof of purchase/ receipts must be submitted and the funds will be deposited directly to your Teachers*Plus* Credit Union account or non-Teachers*Plus* Credit Union members will receive a cheque by mail.

Complete and submit the application form. Wish List Grants will be awarded to proposals that match the following goals/ themes of adding to their classroom:

- Inclusion
- Equity & Diversity
- Sustainability/ climate change
- Social-emotional learning (SEL)
- Culturally responsive teaching
- Healthy active living
- Direct benefits to school and community
- Durable versus disposable items will be given priority
