There will be 40 Wish List Grants awarded up to a maximum of \$300.00 per grant.

#### Who is eligible to apply?

- Must be currently teaching in the province of Nova Scotia.
- Teachers Plus Credit Union Members & non-members are eligible.
- Membership includes one of the following accounts:

➤ Direct deposit
➤ Mortgage

➤ Loan/ Line of Credit➤ Pre-authorized payment➤ RRSP➤ Tax-free savings account

• Entrants must complete and submit the grant application form by:

#### Friday, October 10th, 2025

• NOTE: Immediate family of TPCU Board of Directors & Staff are ineligible for the Wish List Grant. Immediate family is defined as a spouse, parent, grandparent, children, grandchildren, siblings, in-laws and step-family.

#### Eligible items:

- Items must have direct benefit to student learning, your classroom, and daily teaching practice.
- Posters, books, classroom enhancement & organization
- Items to support classroom initiatives that fit within the suggested themes\*
- Teacher resources (books, technology, digital resources)

#### Ineligible items:

- Disposable items or "single/ one time use" items are not eligible.
- Furniture/ lights/ lamps are not eligible (items that do not pass fire code.)
- **NOTE:** Priority will be given to items above and beyond what is typically provided by the school, Board, Centre for Education, or NS Department of Education.
- Teachers are encouraged to discuss their proposed purchases with their school Admin to avoid duplication of items.

#### Wish List Grants will be awarded to proposals that match the following THEMES/ goals:

• Equity, diversity & inclusion Sustainability

Social- emotional learning (SEL)
 Cooperation

#### Important/ Please note:

- The decision of the committee is final.
- Wish List Grants will be awarded in late October/ early November. Successful applicants will be notified by email.
- Successful applicants must submit receipts for refunds.
- If you are awarded one of the grants, proof of purchase/ receipts must be submitted within 30 days. The funds will be deposited directly to your Teachers Plus Credit Union account; non-Teachers Plus Credit Union members will receive a cheque by mail.
- Teachers who do not submit receipts for purchases within the required time line will not receive their funds.
